Enclosed please find registration forms for the upcoming academic year. We request that you fill out and return these to us as soon as possible with a **\$25 deposit per student**, applicable to your total tuition expense. Outstanding tuition balances from the past school year must be resolved as expeditiously as possible. Our policy prohibits us from accepting students into our programs in the Fall if the Synagogue accounts are in arrears. As an additional reminder, all Bar/Bat Mitzvah fees must be paid in advance of the scheduled Bar/Bat Mitzvah date and Synagogue accounts must be current. If you have any questions regarding your account balance please contact our treasurer.

Tuition rates reflect a slight increase and now include materials fees. As in the past, nonmember rates are higher than member fees but all are welcome to enroll in our pre Bar/Bat Mitzvah programs.* We offer a second child discount for all subsequent children enrolled in Sunday Camp or any Tuesday night program. Confirmation class and Bar/Bat Mitzvah students have a separate discount system. Our cap on member family expenditures for religious education programs remains \$900, exclusive of Bar/Bat Mitzvah study. Our seven year old students attend the Aleph-Bet program on Tuesday nights, meeting weekly from 6:00 to 7:15 p.m. Step-Up students meet weekly from 6:00 to 7:45 p.m. Grades 4,5,6 attend on Tuesday nights from 6:00 to 8:15. Your child must be picked up at the end of his/her session. No childcare is available at the Synagogue when classes are in session.

Please note that we will continue our regular billing system. Be prepared to make a payment prior to the first night of class. *If you are in need of scholarship assistance please check this off at the top of the registration form and appropriate materials will be forwarded to you.* If your family has special educational circumstances, plan to speak with our education chair so that needs can be accommodated. We request that you share any IEP information with us so we can program more effectively for your child.
